Learning Communities

Learning communities are designed to bring together instructors from a number of disciplines to explore topics and themes around learning and teaching.

What do participants in a Learning Community do?

Participants become part an inclusive space where members exchange experiences, ideas and strategies about teaching; experiment with research-based practices; discuss research on teaching and learning; build skills; and reflect on their roles as educators. They also conduct a learning, teaching or SOTL research project and share their results with a larger audience. Participants receive a stipend to put toward instructional enhancement activities (e.g., conference travel, student assistants, software or other teaching materials).

Who can apply?

Any full-time member of the Academic Senate at UC Davis may apply to participate in a Learning Community.
